gprt - prt a file in SCCS

#### SYNOPSIS

gprt [ options ] [ files ]

## DESCRIPTION

The gprt command will do the prt(1S) command on the files named. All input flags are passed directly to the prt(1S) command. The files are accessed through the  $g_find(1S)$  command.

The command line arguments are files or any valid option to the prt(1S) command. If a *file* is specified, all \$SUBSYSTEMS in \$SCCSOURCE are searched in the order of \$SUBSYSTEMS for a file named *s.file*. When found, *gdelta* executes prt(1S) on the file with the appropriate directories and "s." prepended to the file name.
