SYNOPSIS

/etc/idump [-]inumber [...] device [...] [[[-]inumber [...]] device] ...

DESCRIPTION

Idump dumps all information about inode number *inumber* from the specified *device*(s). If the '-' is not specified, *idump* will print the inode structure information.

If the '-' is specified, *idump* throws the actual contents of the file onto the standard output. If the file is a directory, the output is formatted to look like an "Is -af".
