lfumount – unmount the logical file system (LFS)

SYNOPSIS

lfumount char_dev

DESCRIPTION

Lfumount unmounts a Logical File System (LFS); i.e., the block device containing the physical storage for the LFS is disassociated from the character device for the LFS in question (see lfmount(1)). The character special file char_dev is assumed to be in /dev. The entry for $/dev/char_dev$ is also removed from the mount table in /etc/lmtab.

/dev/char_dev	Character special file, one per LFS

DIAGNOSTICS

Diagnostics are given if UNIX returns errors on opening, reading, or writing /etc/lmtab, or if *char_dev* is not present in the internal mount table kept by the LFS software. The use of *lfumount* is limited to the super user. A diagnostic is given otherwise.

WARNINGS

Since /etc/lmtab is maintained separately from the internal mount table, they can become inconsistent. Thus, it is possible for *lfumount* to complain that *char_dev* is not in /etc/lmtab, although it correctly removed it from the internal table.
