rpg - run an rpg program

SYNOPSIS

rpg [options] <filename> [arguments]

DESCRIPTION

The "rpg" command is used to execute RPG programs from the UNIX shell. On some systems the command name may be "nrpg". Several options are available with this command:

- +d - invoke dynamic debugger
- d - do not invoke dynamic debugger (default)
- +t - turn on execution tracing
- t - do not turn on execution tracing (default)
- +p - trace all "+switch", "+sccs", and "*xeq" commands.
- p - do not trace paths (default)
- +w - print all warning messages (default)
- w - do not print warning messages
