sccstring - echo SCCS keywords to standard output

SYNOPSIS

sccstring file

DESCRIPTION

The sccstring command will echo SCCS keywords WW to the standard output surrounded by the appropriate characters to make the entire string a comment. Sccstring knows the comment conventions for files whose suffices are:

*.[chly], *.mk, [Mm]akefile, *.sh

The output string is a legitimate comment for each of the types of file.

Sccstring is used by the addsccs(1S) command to automatically add the SCCS keyword string to named files.

All diagnostics are printed on file descriptor 2.

BUGS

There is no way to specify the type of file other than the suffix.
