NAME

start - restore printing of queued line printer jobs

SYNOPSIS

start type item [item]

DESCRIPTION

Start restores printing of a set of line printer requests which were inhibited by a hold or restrain command. Start causes printing to begin at the beginning of the job. Type (either user, printer, or job) indicates the type of *items* which follow. At least one *item* is required.

In the case of *typeuser*, the *items* are login ids of users with queued jobs. For each specified user, *start* begins printing of all the user's line printer jobs, regardless of the queue in which the request resides. If the *type* is **printer**, then each *item* is a printer name, and *start* allows the printers to service their respective queues. For *typejob*, each of the specified jobs is restored to a printable state.
