NAME

lnxx - return name of current terminal

SYNOPSIS

lnxx (filedes)

DESCRIPTION

Lnxx searches for the last two characters (if 2 char field option elected) or the last character (if 1 char field selected) of the terminal's name which is specified by the argument *filedes* (file descriptor of a file). If kk is returned, the terminal name is then "/dev/lnkk". If k is returned, the terminal name is then "/dev/lnkk".

xx is returned if the indicated file does not correspond to a terminal.

NOTE

This routine has been replaced in newer versions of the library by *toyname*(3C).
