acct — accounting file

DESCRIPTION

When a process terminates, an accounting record is written into the accounting files `/usr/adm/acct` if system accounting has been activated. This file may be summarized by using `sa(1)`. The format of this file is:

char   ac_comm[14] /* name of command */
char   ac_flag     /* unused */
char   ac_uid      /* real userid */
long   ac_date     /* start time of command */
long   ac_etime    /* elapsed time in seconds */
long   ac_utime    /* user cpu time (1/60 sec) */
long   ac_stime    /* system time (1/60 sec) */
long   ac_dread    /* disk reads */
long   ac_dwrit    /* disk writes */
};
```
