This command changes (or installs) a password associated with the user name.

The program prompts for the old password and then for the new one. The caller must supply both. New passwords must be at least four characters long if they use a sufficiently rich alphabet and at least six characters long if monocase.

Only the owner of the name or the super-user may change a password, and in addition the old password must be known.
