DESCRIPTION

Lnxx extracts the last character (or 2 characters for double character identifiers) of the terminal name which is the standard input or is specified by the argument *filedes* (file descriptor of a file). If the terminal name is "/dev/lnk", k is returned; if "/dev/lnkk", kk is returned.

If the file description does not correspond to a terminal, "xx" is returned.
