*Umount* announces to the system that the removable file system previously mounted on special file *special* is to be removed. Only the super-user may unmount file systems.

### DIAGNOSTICS

Frequently, in the case of *lusr*, the file system is found to be busy because one of the Shell accounting files (*lusr/adm/sh\_acct* or *lusr/adm/su\_acct*) is open for some Shell or system accounting is active (*lusr/adm/acct*).
