

DFILE,N - A Program for TSS-516

Sometimes files are inadvertantly created with names that contain nonprinting control characters or the symbol @. It is not possible to delete these files with the "!" command.

The system level command DFILE,N deletes the Nth file from the user's catalogue, independent of its name. A listing of the program is attached.

The system level command DFILE, N prints the Nth file name preceded by the command "!". A subsequent system level command, ?2, will then actually delete the file and also two other temporary files, ?1 and ?2. SYS? p,dfile SINK,?1 E !?2 >72 L >?1 =?2 s1,999/^/!/ D1,#1 P1 D2,999 I1 sink,?1 E I2
